Pryor Creek Golf Course will present the 2nd Annual Pryor BooHaHa Halloween Festival on October 28, 29, and 30th at the golf course. Our goal is to offer a free family-friendly Halloween event to entertain all ages. There will be a carnival area set up along the front part of the golf course with free admittance. Businesses, organizations, and vendors will be set up with games, activities, candy, prizes, music, a bonfire (if no burn ban is in effect), food trucks, and more. We will also offer a 35-minute long haunted hayride, The Haunted Mile, attracting an audience of all ages, however, YOUNGSTERS BEWARE!! The nearly two-mile-long hayride will span 425+ acres of wooded and open trails to the Neosho River and back featuring "The Legend of 7 Iron Jack" Seats are limited! Tickets may be purchased online or in person at the event if tickets are still available. Seeking Sponsors

We are looking for businesses, organizations, or individuals that would financially sponsor this event.

Title Sponsor - \$500

- Includes free booth set up in Carnival Area or a Spook Station (see below)

Advertising Sponsor - \$300

- Name listed on a directional map given out to everyone when they enter

Seeking Vendors

We are seeking food trucks, vendors, businesses, or organizations to set up in the Carnival Area.

- <u>Vendors</u> \$225.00 (those who charge for products or services: food truck, art entertainers, petting zoo, etc.)
- <u>Trunk or Treat</u> No charge for set up (decorate a trunk out of your commercial or personal vehicle)
- <u>Promotional Booth</u> no charge for set up (those who are not charging for product or services. You may set up a table with or without a canopy)

Expectations include:

- Setting up for all three nights of the event: Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, October 28, 29, and 30th. You may begin setting up any time before the event. You may begin setting up any time before the event. You may leave your booth set up overnight, however, we are not liable for these or vandalism.
- For all promotional booths a special activity with prizes or candy to be handed out (for example, carnival game with candy or prizes, cake walk, bingo, coloring contest, storytelling, arts, and craft projects, etc.)
- The vendor is responsible for obtaining all necessary sales permits and supplying their own table and/or canopy
- Limited Electric Available ask for details. Vendor supplies own electric cords.
- You can choose where you set up (see attached map) however, locations are on a first come, first serve basis. Register early to get the best spot!

Seeking Spookers

We are looking for businesses, organizations, or individuals that would like to set up Spook Stations along the haunted hayride trail or even participate as a spooker. We have Spook Stations that are looking for volunteers. If you are able to set up a Spook Station, you are free to create your own spook station however you choose.

Three areas to choose from: 7 Iron Jack's Place, Hidden in the Woods, or along the trail.

Jack's Place - \$1,000 (available to one group)

- This is the 'Main Stage" where evidence of "7 Iron Jack" will be found. Details on this legend will be provided. This is a large, secluded and dark area that backs up to the Neosho River.
- Includes Title Sponsorship with name and logo promotional flyers, banners, and directional map to be given to everyone when they enter.

Hidden in the Woods and Open Areas Along the Trail - No charge to set up

 You can hide in the woods to create a scare factor or be out in the open so that riders can see you before they approach Spook Stations.

• Set up for all three nights during event hours: Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, October 28, 29, and 30th. You may begin setting up at any time before the event. You may leave your station/area set up overnight, however, we are not liable for theft or vandalism.
